



Leadership Team meeting, March 2023

The following are highlights from the submitted reports.

Pastor Darren: Plans are underway for the Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter services. Pastor Darren reported that the Cornhole tournament and silent auction raised just under \$2800. All of the proceeds will be split between Dassel Elementary School for a gaga pit and the D-C Girls' Swim Team for new parkas. He also highlighted the Rural Impact Leadership Conference which was held in Alexandria on March 18. Confirmation will be May 21 and Pastor Darren's last Sunday will be May 28.

Youth Pastor: Tim updated the Team on the youth program and upcoming events. The students are looking forward to the lock-in on March 28-29. He reported that the regular youth group will meet through April 26. The month of May is off because of the many year-end activities at school. The summer schedule and events are being planned along with the local mission trip in July.

Stewardship and Finance: Ron reported on the March 12 meeting of the Team. Items included:
