Custodial: Randy & Marcia Dischinger Thank you for the warm welcome we have received in our first month here. And, thank you for your patience as we learn your names and begin to know you. It is our joy to begin getting to know you and to serve with you as your transitional pastors.

This is a **very important time in the life of Dassel Covenant Church**. It is our goal, in conjunction with the Leadership Team and all of you and under the direction of the Holy Spirit, to assist DCC in a healthy period between long-term pastors. Please be in prayer with us that this will be a time when each of us flourishes both personally and corporately as followers of Jesus.

Please join us for a presentation and a time of Q & A on expectations for this time of transition. Come either of the Sundays of August 20 or 27 at 9:00 a.m. in the Fellowship Hall. We will give a short presentation on the common phases of a time of transition in the life of a church, followed by an opportunity for Q & A. Though every church has its own context, culture and history, there are some **common characteristics to transitions**. Additionally, this information will help explain some of the thoughts and feelings found to be common to members and friends of any church at such a time. If you find yourself wondering, "Why do we need transitional pastors?" or "Why can't we just select a search team and get on with finding a new long-term pastor?"or "What thoughts and emotions are normal for me to have at a time like this?" please join us. Even if you are just curious about what the aim of the transition period is, please do join us.

Starting in September you may notice a special feature incorporated into **our Communion** service. This is something specifically for parents with young children. In the September service of Communion (on the 10th due to the Community Service on the 3rd at Gethsemane Lutheran) we will be including grapes for young children. The children will be served grapes when their parents and older siblings receive the elements of Communion. Just like the decision of when a child understands enough about Communion to receive the juice and bread, so the decision of whether to take grapes for their your young ones is entirely up to parents. The purpose of the inclusion of grapes for these tiny ones is to remind us that they too are part of our church family, following Jesus. You may have noticed that in both the liturgies of Baby Dedication and Baby Baptism, the congregation pledges to support the parents in praying for, guiding and nurturing the children of our church in knowing, loving and following Jesus. Including a way for our children to participate in this very important sacrament of the church can contribute to their sense that they too can be part of the "vine of Christ."

11:30-12:00 pm on Saturday.






Wednesday, August 16


Transition Presentations and O &A



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Leadership Team meeting, July 24, 2023

On behalf of the Women Ministries Team, Julie Ardoff brought a request to the Leadership Team to update the nursery with new paint, furniture and toys. In the discussion, it was decided to include new carpet as well. Ron reported there is money in the Capital Improvement Fund and the general maintenance line item in the budget to cover the costs. Motion to approve up to \$2,500.00 for the nursery remodel project was made by Wayne, seconded by Ron. Carried unanimously.

Bill Ward gave a brief report on what the Vitality Taskforce has been doing. He highlighted three things:

Who we are as a church (demographics)

Wisdom from previous Vitality effort

Developing a survey to engage the congregation in the process

The results of the survey and recommendations will be presented to the Leadership Team and the Congregation. Pastor Linda stressed the importance of a collaborative effort between the Vitality Taskforce, the Leadership Team and the Call Committee. The NW Conference Vitality materials will be used as a follow-up to the survey.

Pastor's Report

Pastor Linda and Pastor Marv are grateful for the welcome they have received. They have met with several people sharing coffee or a meal and have had good conversations. Pastor Keith gave them a tour of the Lakeside Care Center and Apartments, introducing them to members of the church and key staff members. They have attended several ministry team meetings in July.

Pastor Linda will be teaching Confirmation in the fall. She plans to use the Covenant curriculum beginning with the New Testament. They are recommending a small addition to the service of communion. A bowl of grapes will be available for children who come forward with their parents. They will include instruction to help parents in their personal decision for their children.

Pastor Mary shared his thoughts on teaching a Sunday school class this fall on resolving conflicts; preaching a series on the book of James and incorporating "Hymn of the Week" and a story during the service.

Pastor Linda and Pastor Mary presented a video clip from "Ending Well." This is a product of the ECC they would like to use to facilitate a healthy time of transition for the congregation. This will be offered Sunday mornings at 9:00 a.m. on August 20 and August 27. Pastor Mary informed us of their upcoming schedule. We briefly discussed the search process, how soon will we be ready to begin and the importance of the transitional process.

Wayne made a motion to approve all the reports submitted (Christian Education, Properties and Maintenance, Women Ministry, Worship and Music) except Stewardship and Finance Team by consent agenda, seconded by Diane. Carried unanimously.

Ron highlighted the Stewardship and Finance Team report. The finances look good. The Tentmaker's refund has been received. Motion made by Marcia to approve the Stewardship and Finance report as presented, seconded by Diane. Carried unanimously.

Old Business- due to the time and upcoming prayer meeting, the following items were tabled. Pastor Linda will meet with Marcia and Diane before the next meeting to discuss the following draft items:

- 1. Dealing with members who willfully neglect their responsibilities to the church or who err in doctrine or conduct
- 2. Security Plan / Safety Team Training Procedure
- 3. Church membership

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Mission Trip Needed:

Prescription medicine containers for Ecuador Mission Trip. .The mission team will be bringing the containers to be used in the medical clinic. They must be WASHED and LABELS RE-MOVED. Please place in the box by the Missions display.

Home For At Risk Children (Santiago Partnership)

The Home for At Risk Children is in need of new twin size quilts. We brought down quilts for them 2016, but there are now 20 children instead of 10 that were originally in the Home. If you would like to donate a quilt top or money towards the purchase of supplies for the quilts, please mark your check "Ecuador Quilts". It takes about 5 yards of fabric for the top and another 5 yards of fabric for the backing. Fabric costs have risen to almost \$13 / yard.
