





Leadership Team meeting, December 11, 2023

Pastor's Report - Pastor Marv and Pastor Linda are preparing their next sermon series which will be teaching the key points of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. They also informed us of their meeting with Kara Stromberg, Northwest Conference Superintendent. Topics of discussion included the current transition, the search team committee member qualities, the process of selection of search team members and the Leadership Team's duty to annually review the membership roster to determine inactivity.

The following submitted reports were reviewed:

- <u>Christian Education</u> KidsQuest and youth group will have Christmas parties on December 13 and will break until January 17; Unite (formerly CHIC) is July 15-19, 2024 in Bowling Green, Ohio. Fundraisers are being planned;
- <u>Worship and Music</u> Mary Rinden is leading the choir for the Christmas Eve services; the Technology Team (Josh Olson, Tony Amundson, Chad Ardoff) are working on the livestream; it was recommended that the Leadership Team send a note to the donor of the technology funds to thank him for the money given to improve the livestream capabilities;
- <u>Women Ministries</u> Community meal for January will be done by the youth. A \$1000 donation was given by the family of Chris Hansen to be used for our community meals. The WM booklets will be printed soon;
- <u>Visitation</u> highlights of the report are the Thanksgiving offering; birthday coffee time at Lakeside; poinsettias and cookies will be delivered to 22 members and friends of the church; the Visitation team will assist the pastors in serving communion monthly for the residents at Lakeside Nursing Home.
- <u>Stewardship and Finance</u> Ron reported the old business of the increased insurance premium cost. The Team made a recommendation to give a monetary gift to Randy Dischinger for stepping in as volunteer youth director. Motion made by Wayne, seconded by Diane. Motion carried with Marcia abstaining from the vote.

Ron highlighted the new business discussed at the Stewardship and Finance meeting. This included making a principal payment on the building loan in December with an additional \$20,000 from the over/under fund in January, 2024; creating a separate line item under the Student Event Fund for LBBC Scholarships per an anonymous donation; and a request for use of the over/under fund for the youth to attend the Family Winter Retreat in February. The 2023 financial books will be closed on January 2, 2024.

There was discussion about lining up auditors for the 2023 financial records. Paulette Dahlseng will serve as one of the auditors and names were suggested for the second auditor. Ron will contact them. It was decided that the Women Ministries Fund would be included in the general church audit. The Benevolent Fund is audited separately.

Ron presented the pre-draft of the 2024 budget. Salaries for the office secretary, bookkeeper and custodian were increased by 3.2% (cost of living). The Pastor and Youth Pastor salaries remain the same as 2023 as the positions are not filled. There was a suggestion at the last annual meeting to increase the percentages of support to the ECC (10%) and the NW Conference (5%). It was decided to stay at the same amounts of 8% and 4% respectively. Again, Ron mentioned the dramatic increase in the church insurance premium which will increase the proposed 2024 budget.

During the discussion of the proposed budget, Marcia made a motion to add a line item to the Missions budget to support The Santiago Partnership (Ecuador) in the amount of \$1200 per year. Ron seconded the motion. Carried unanimously.

The election will take place at the annual meeting on January 28, 2024. Motion to approve the ballot as presented was made by Ron, seconded by Tom. Carried unanimously.
