

Worship Leader – Job Description

Dassel Covenant Church

Objective:

The worship leader is responsible for leading the congregation into worship so that they are transformed into maturing followers of Jesus Christ.

Qualifications:

- Have a growing mature relationship with Jesus Christ
- Worship leading experience
- Possess a heart for worshipping God, having the ability to connect the congregation with God, enabling them to draw closer to Him
- A strong musician, who can lead a congregation effectively into worship
- A team player who can develop and work with volunteers who participate on the worship team
- Have a commitment to the mission and values of Dassel Covenant Church and in agreement with the Evangelical Covenant Church affirmations.

Responsibilities:

- Develop the congregational worship experience so the congregation is increasingly transformed into the image of Jesus Christ
- Lead a blended style of worship on Sunday Morning
- Build a team of musical volunteers to serve and help develop the worship ministry.
- Select songs for the worship service, keeping organized records
- Weekly planning; organize the volunteers for the worship team, communicate with them clearly, lead the weekly rehearsal and communicate effectively with the church office about Sunday worship information by Thursday morning
- Work with the Senior Pastor and the Music and Worship Commission in building the worship service
- Work with the Music and Worship Commission developing what equipment or technology is needed, and in preparing the yearly budget
- Sunday Morning work with the pastor, the sound tech, the video presenter and others as needed to enable a worship experience that pleases God
- Lead worship at special services also, Good Friday, Christmas Eve, etc....

Accountability:

- To the Senior Pastor weekly
- To the Music and Worship Commission monthly
- To the Congregation annually
