It takes about 5 yards of fabric for the top and another 5 yards of fabric for the backing. Fabric costs have risen to almost \$13 / yard.

It is an exciting time in Women Ministries! We have started monthly Community Meals, we have some great ideas for this spring, and have many new members to the board!



Leadership Team meeting, February 2023

The following are highlights from the submitted reports. Reports:

Pastor Darren: Will be finishing up the series on Psalms in March. Pastor Hollis Kim, Director of Pastoral Care and Development, NWC, will be preaching on March 12. Preparations are being made for Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter services. In April and May, Pastor Darren's messages will be from 2 Timothy. Confirmation is scheduled for May 21. Stewardship and Finance - Ron highlighted the following from the S&F report:

- 2. Wayne called for the vote on the assignment of officers: See pg 3 of the Newsletter for officers.

6. Darren talked about what could happen at the ECC annual meeting in June with 2 churches being voted out of the

Covenant for their stance on human sexuality. The Covenant Church as a whole could split.
