Custodial: Randy & Marcia Dischinger Romans 12:3–5 – "Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you. For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others."

The message of these verses is highly applicable for churches today just as it was during the New Testament time period. Paul uses the human body to illustrate our dependency on each other. Yet we know that just as our physical body isn't always healthy, likewise churches often struggle to become healthy. We're looking forward to bringing a special workshop and teaching series that we hope will be an encouragement and help for our church.

**Next Step in Church Transitions: Healthy Church Systems Workshop**Please join us Saturday morning, October 28<sup>th</sup> from 9:00-12:00 for a workshop on changing the culture of our church to be one which understands, prevents and resolves conflict.

The workshop will include a series of teaching videos produced by Covenant Missional Vitality explaining the dynamics of relationships in churches. We will learn how to recognize when change produces anxiety in our church family and what are the unhealthy responses that can result. We will also learn how to respond in a healthy manner, so our church can be empowered to become mature in its ability to prevent and resolve potential conflicts. Finally, we will learn the power of such spiritual practices as gratitude, remembrance, confession, lament, laughter and developing a rule of life which provide protection against unhealthy relationships and promote healthy ones.

We are looking forward to a great morning of interaction and conversation on steps we can take to become a more healthy church.

### Fall Teaching Series on the Ingredients of Healthy Relationships

Please make it a priority to join us for our Sunday morning worship services this fall beginning on the 8<sup>th</sup> of October when we will launch a new teaching series on the ingredients of healthy relationships. We will look at our own identity in Jesus and the image of God in others, especially the difficult people in our lives. We will explore sources and common responses to conflict and learn the elements of an authentic apology. Come and learn with us how to have conversations that actually heal instead of making a problem worse. Finally, examine with us what forgiveness really is and what it is not and just how powerful it can be to set us free from anger and pain that is only hurting us!

We're looking forward to bringing this series of messages and pray that they will both challenge and inspire us in our relationships with one another.



# Leadership Team meeting, September 18, 2023

# Reports

# Vitality Task Force

Bill Ward gave a report on Vitality. The Task Force has been meeting since June 12 and is now at the stage of determining how to accomplish the identified themes of the survey. Bill explained the need to keep moving forward and the buy-in from the congregation and their involvement. A rough draft of the Vitality Report will be presented at the October Leadership Team meeting. The next step will be a joint meeting of the Leadership Team and Vitality Task Force on October 30, 2023 at 5:00 pm.

# Pastors Report

Pastor Marv and Pastor Linda highlighted their current sermon series on Colossians. The next series of sermons will focus on the ingredients of developing healthy relationships and resolving conflicts. They are excited to offer a Saturday morning seminar on October 28. The theme is "Healthy Systems in the Church." This video series was developed by the ECC and it covers healthy transitions in the church. Pastor Marv and Pastor Linda continue to meet people and are getting to know us.

The submitted reports were reviewed (Christian Education, Properties and Maintenance, Women Ministries, Stewardship and Finance). Marcia indicated there was great support for the youth fundraiser lunch on Sunday; Al commended Tom Hedlund for the nice job on the patio area; it is hoped that the cracks in the parking lot will be sealed and stripes painted this fall. Women Ministries is adding a Fall banquet as a new yearly event. Ron highlighted a few items from the Stewardship and Finance Team report: the are working on a memorial pamphlet; insurance premium increase due to valuation increase in property; budget planning for 2024.

The S&F Team is discussing ways to accurately reflect the budget since we are currently not paying health insurance or a pension for the transitional pastors or the youth director salary/benefits.

Motion to approve the reports as presented was made by Ron, seconded by Tom. Carried unanimously.

### Old Business

Security Plan Update - Tom has contacted several people who have agreed to be on the Security Task Force. The documents developed by Diane and Marcia, with input from Pastor Marv and Pastor Linda will be shared with them.

### New Business

- A. 2024 Budget. Ministry Teams will be given the 2023 year-to-date detail expenditure report for their respective teams this week. Stewardship and Finance request the budget worksheets be returned by their November meeting in order to have a first draft of the 2024 budget to the Leadership Team by the November 23 meeting.
- B. Nominating Committee. Ron, Tom and Gwen Hallquist will meet to start the process of securing nominations for the 2024 ballot. Marcia Dischinger and Wayne Jorgenson are the Leadership Team members up for re-election. The election will take place at the annual meeting in January.
- C. Rental Agreements and Funeral Policy. Diane presented the draft changes to the current church rental agreement and funeral policy. Primary updates are in the fees charged. Leadership Team members were asked to read and provide feedback to Diane before the October 16 meeting.

Those are Service, Education, Mutual Support, Conflict Resolution, Music, Church Mission, Missions/Evangelism, Worship, Youth, Marketing/Telling Our Story, Governance and Staffing.

The team spent the first half of its work time understanding our own church and local region. We are now into the phase of specific recommendations in each of the twelve themes.

It is our anticipation that the Vitality work and report will serve as a foundation for the selection of future pastoral staff, so we are busy trying to wrap up our work in a timely fashion, with an October presentation to the Leadership Team.

Meetings are Mondays at 5 p.m. in the library and visitors are welcome.
